



Pediatric and Adolescent Eyelash Growth Study

Has your child experienced a reduction in fullness, darkness, length or number of eyelashes following cancer chemotherapy?

If so, your child may qualify for participation in a clinical research study for an investigational drug being studied for eyelash growth.

Your child may be eligible if he/she:

- Is between 5 and 17 years of age
- Has a parent's/legal guardian's written consent
- Has completed their chemotherapy treatment for cancer at least 4 weeks but no more than 24 weeks prior to the study beginning and is now post-chemotherapy or on maintenance chemotherapy
- Meets the baseline eyelash evaluation scores
- Satisfies other study entry requirements (as evaluated by study site staff)

The study will last 5 months and will include 6-7 visits to the study site. You and/or your child may receive compensation for your time and travel. Eligible participants may receive, at no cost, the following supplies and/or procedures:

- Study medication
- Study-related eye exams
- Study-related physical exams
