The program currently includes 10 full time hospitalists, a complement of Internal and Family Medicine, and two midlevel providers. At Memorial, hospitalists have the opportunity to work more predictable hours, yet with unpredictable cases. The practice treats patients with a wide range of socio-economic backgrounds and interesting pathology. Providers have the opportunity to cooperate in the care of varied medical issues across many specialties, including surgery, ICU and our Level II Trauma Center.

The hospitalist department at Memorial is well respected in the community; providers receive immense support from the specialists with whom they work. In addition, our highly skilled radiology department provides procedural support for our hospitalists. High-patient satisfaction scores combined with low-turnover rates demonstrate the stability of the hospitalist program. The unique scheduling system allows providers to create a work-life balance, while group congeniality within the program generates a positive work atmosphere. A full time position includes approximately 18 shifts per month, some nights and some days.
