Memorial Health System is deeply rooted in the northern Indiana/southern Michigan region, as evidenced by over 100 years of service to the nearly one million residents who choose to make it their home.

As proof of our dedication to providing an exceptional "Quality of Life" to the patients we serve, Memorial has undergone a number of major enhancements in recent years including a \$90 million surgical expansion, the development of a Regional Cancer Center, as well as caring for those youngest members of our area through the establishment of Memorial Children's Hospital that is scheduled for expansion in late-2010.



We are very proud of our accomplishments made thus far in attracting a number of quality Pediatric Sub-specialists to our community, including a full compliment of Pediatric Intensivists, Perinatologists, and Pediatric Hospitalists, as well as specialists in the fields of Hematology/Oncology, Infectious Diseases, Pulmonology, Developmental Pediatrics, and Pediatric Neurology.

Memorial Health System currently includes Memorial Hospital, a 526-bed Level II Trauma Center and a 36-bed Level IIIB neonatal intensive care unit. Our facilities offer a 10-bed pediatric intensive care unit, 20 general pediatric beds, in addition to an eight-bed pediatric hematology/oncology unit. With the planned Memorial Children's Hospital expansion, these levels will increase to a 50-bed Level IIIB neonatal intensive care unit, 12-bed pediatric intensive care unit, 38-bed pediatric unit, and an eight-bed pediatric hematology/oncology unit. Memorial's surgical suite replacement project increased the number of operating rooms from 15 to 22, expanded the quantity of recovery rooms from 18 to 27, and enlarged the number of pre-surgery beds from 8 to 15.

We are dedicated to increasing the level of surgical care available in the Michiana region to include two Pediatric Surgeons. To lay the foundation for and to provide guidance to the department, we are aggressively seeking an experienced, **Board Certified Pediatric Surgeon** to assume the role of **Medical Director** to oversee this new division and to work in a blended clinical and administrative capacity. The ideal candidate will have prior administrative experience and have a strong desire to work in a highly visible role. The Medical Director will be the key leader in establishing the infrastructure and procedures utilized by the department, while having integral involvement and decision making responsibilities in the recruitment of a second surgeon.

Memorial Health System is fortunate to partner with The University of Notre Dame and Indiana University School of Medicine in the training of its medical students. The ability to have academic involvement is available, as is participation in clinical research.

The greater South Bend metro area is a remarkable region of 170,000 residents that provides a highly diverse setting to reside in from cultural, recreational, educational, college level sports, residential, and retail perspectives. South Bend has a number of attractions including the Broadway Theatre League, Moreau Center for the Arts at St. Mary's College, the Morris Performing Arts Center, South Bend Symphony Orchestra, South Bend Civic Theatre, College Football Hall of Fame, and Memorial Health System's award winning HealthWorks! Kids' Museum, among others. The area boasts 13 institutions of higher education, including **The University of Notre Dame**, as well as other four- and two-year programs.

South Bend truly offers the best all of options with the comfort and appeal of a college community that is located only 90 minutes from one of the most exciting metropolitan cities in the world. Access to Chicago is readily available via Interstate 80/90. For those who prefer to ride rather than drive, commuter train service is available at South Bend Regional Airport with stops throughout northern Indiana, ending at Michigan Avenue in downtown Chicago. Direct flights are available to Atlanta, Chicago/O'Hare, Cincinnati, Clearwater, Cleveland, Detroit, Las Vegas, New York, and Orlando.
